Race to the Top

In our previous newsletters, we shared information about Project 1 and Project 2 of Warren Township's federal Race to the Top grant, which will help the district increase student achievement, provide greater opportunities for personalized learning, and ensure students' readiness for post-secondary college and career opportunities. Please read about Project 3 below.

Project 3: Positive Behavior Support System

Warren will create a system of tiered behavioral interventions called a Positive Behavioral Interventions and Supports (PBIS) system. Teachers and administrators will receive professional development for PBIS and culturally-responsive instructional practices. Warren will also create a school-parent initiative for kindergarten through 6th grade families called *Parents are the CORE*. Evening workshop activities will be held throughout the year to help unite the school community to promote positive social, academic, and emotional growth and well-being of our students.
