

2013-2014 Renaissance Middle School Standardized Wear Policy

All students must enter the building in dress code ready to succeed each day.

Acceptable Shirts/Sweaters

Collared Shirts with Sleeves

- Solid, stripes or plaids
- Modest neckline/no more than 2 buttons unbuttoned
- Halter-tops, bare midriff, see-through apparel or fishnet garments are not to be worn.
- No patterns, pictures or other designs
- Appropriate size
- Sweatshirts/sweaters may be worn over the collared shirt
- No hooded sweatshirts/sweaters/shirts except for spirit wear on days designated by the director or designee

Acceptable Pants/Skirts/Dress/

- Plain no decoration-pants/**shorts/skirts dress or .Capri's worn appropriately and at least knee length
- Any solid colored pants
- **NO Blue jeans**, sweat pants, stretch pants/leggings or yoga-type pants are **NOT ACCEPTABLE**

Acceptable Footwear

- Tennis shoes, sandals with Straps
- Boots
- No flip flops, house slippers , shower shoes

Outerwear

- Must be locked up at the beginning of the day
- What constitutes "outerwear" is solely the discretion of the director or designee
- Any material vests or Fleece outerwear with buttons or a zipper are not considered substitutes for a collared shirt

Miscellaneous

- Hats, caps, sunglasses, and any other head coverings are not to be worn or carried in the building during the school day.
- No purses larger than a book
- Attire that may damage school property or cause personal injury to others (such as chains, oversized jewelry, or studded items) may not to be worn.
- Anything that denotes membership in a gang, clique, associative organization, or fraternity, advocates drug use or violence, is patently offensive, or promotes disruptive behavior are prohibited.
- All clothing should fit the wearer correctly and be no more than one size larger than necessary to accommodate growth. Neither should clothes jeopardize the modesty or limit the free movement of the wearer.
- No Backpacks, only string tied school supplied book bags

Consequences

Students will call home for a change of clothing and star sheet marked for dress code. Students will remain in STR until they meet dress code requirements either by clothes brought in by a parent or changing into clothes available at school.

Continued defiance of dress code may result in further consequences.
