Each program will: run in weekly sessions at a \$125/child/week fee, operate between 6 am-6 pm & include breakfast, lunch and afternoon snack.

Summer Day Camp will have 2 trips each week included in the weekly fee. You must be pre-registered-deadline for first week is May 21st at 6pm.

Registration begins May 4th & 5th, 5-7pm at the Early Childhood Center (1401 N. Mitthoefer Rd). Additional weeks must be paid in advance of attending.

We have planned and prepared for a very positive testing experience, however, as always, we need parent support to truly be successful. **Please, unless a child is truly sick, do not allow him/her** to miss a day in the testing period.
