TEXTBOOK EVALUATION COMMITTEE NEEDS PARENTS

The Textbook Evaluation Committee needs Warren Township parents to evaluate Mathematics (grades 1-12) textbook and accompanying resources being considered for adoption.

Parents of elementary students may review resources for Mathematics from 8:30 a.m. - 3:30 p.m. at any of the eleven schools from February 16-26, 2010.

Parents of middle school students may review resources for Mathematics from 7:30 a.m.- 3:00 p.m., at Creston, Raymond Park, or Stonybrook from February 16-26, 2010.

Parents of high school students may review resources for Mathematics at Warren Central from 7:30 a.m.-3:00 p.m. from February 16-26, 2010.

Parents should stop at the school office to receive directions for locating the materials to be evaluated.

MSD Warren Township Kindergarten Registration

Parents who are interested in enrolling their child in kindergarten for the 2010-11 school year should plan to attend the Kindergarten Round-Ups that are being held in all Warren Township Elementary buildings and the Warren Early Childhood Center on Thursday, May 6, at 7:00p.m.

Items required to register your child in school include birth certificate, two proofs of residency (copy of lease or mortgage & gas or electric bill), proof of immunizations, parent/guardian photo ID, and proof of custody (if necessary).

"Nurse's Corner"

Disease: Scabies

Symptoms: Rash, small raised bumps, blisters or linear tracts containing mites of their eggs, found commonly between the fingers, on wrists, or waist-line. Cause severe itching especially at night.

Incubation Period: First exposure, 2-6 weeks, subsequent exposure, 1-4 days.

Contagious Period: Until mites and eggs are destroyed, usually after 1-2 treatments.

Return to School: Day after treatment is completed. Occasionally a second treatment is needed.
