## Heather Hills Elementary School's *Dress for Success* Uniformly Dressed Code



The Heather Hills Elementary is a uniformly dressed school. This policy is School Board approved, and it is in effect for the 2009-2010 school year. Students are expected to keep themselves well groomed and neatly dressed at all times. We want children to be comfortable, neat, and clean so they can concentrate on their schoolwork. Because of this school, parents, and community members have opted for a uniformly dressed program at Heather Hills. The following information outlines this policy:

The following uniformly dressed policy must be observed by all students at Heather Hills (see exceptions below).

1. Colors:

- a. **Solid color** dark blue, black, or tan bottoms (this includes long socks, leggings, and hose)
- b. **Solid color** (no striped shirts) blue, white, gray, black, green or red tops.

2. Shirts must have a collar. **Shirts may not bear any logos** except Heather Hills school logos. T-shirts bearing a school logo or a school club logo may be worn.

3. **Shirts must be tucked in.**

4. Solid colored sweatshirts and sweaters are permitted if they are blue, red, or white. They must be free of all logos. A collared shirt must be worn underneath these items. **No hoods on the sweatshirts or sweaters.** Temperature in the classroom can feel cool at times. If you send a sweater or sweatshirt, it must be solid color without a hood.

5. Pants or jumpers (skirts or skorts) must be solid dark blue, black, or tan.

6. No sweat pants, overalls, or jeans will be allowed.

7. Shorts will be acceptable, but must be dark blue, black, or tan. Girls' skirts or boys' or girls' shorts cannot be worn more than 2" above the knee. Shorts may not be worn after Oct. 1 and until after spring break.

8. No "sagging" pants will be allowed and pant hems may not extend beyond the heel of the shoe.

9. It is suggested that students wear a belt when the pants have belt loops. If a belt is worn, it should be black or brown leather only. No canvas, web, or other material belts and no large belt buckles. No long dangling belts.

10. Shoes must be tennis shoes or a black or brown dress shoes. No high heels, and the toes and heels of the shoes must be enclosed. **Boots may be worn during winter weather to school ONLY. They are not to be worn at school. This includes ALL boots. Students must have other shoes to change into at school.**

11. For safety reasons, it is preferred that students not wear jewelry. **No large, dangling, or hoop earrings** or other distracting jewelry (ex. jelly bracelets, rubber bracelets, charm bracelets...) are to be worn. Accessories such as watches, earrings, or hair bows should be discreet.
