The United States Census 2010 is a count of everyone residing in the United States. All United States residents, both citizens and non citizens, must be counted. Results from the Census will determine funding for many programs including schools. Census forms will be mailed to all households beginning March 15. Please complete the form and return in the postage paid envelop. In late April, Census workers will begin visiting households not returning forms. For assistance with your questionnaire, the Warren Trustee's office (501 N. Post Road) will have a bilingual (English/Spanish) Census employee on site on Tuesdays, Wednesday and Thursdays from 8:00 am - 1:00 pm beginning March 23 through April 15. The Telephone Questionnaire Assistance Center, 1-866-872-6868, is open from 8:00 am through 9:00 pm. A Spanish-speaking operator can be reached at 1-866-928-2010. COLD AND FLU SEASON TIPS & FACTS

- Children miss 22 million days of school days a year due to the common cold.
- During the height of cold and flu season, over half of school nurses send 5 or 6 kids home every day.
- Flu viruses can live up to 48 hours on surfaces such as doorknobs and telephone receivers.
- Disinfect frequently touched surfaces to help reduce the spread of germs.
