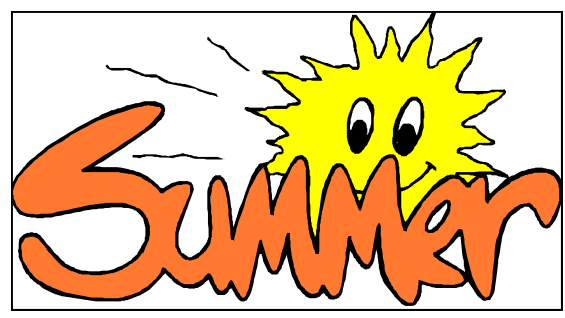
Fall Recreational Soccer Signups

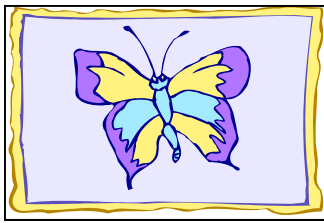
