


FAMILY LEARNING NIGHT

CONDITION: Strep Throat

SYMPTOMS: A sore throat and fever are the most pronounced symptoms.

INCUBATION PERIOD: 1-3 days average 2-3 days.

CONTAGIOUS PERIOD: Weeks or months without medical treatment or with antibiotic treatment 24-48 hours.

RETURN TO SCHOOL: Adequate treatment for 24-48 hours, and symptoms subside.
