## IT'S THAT TIME OF YEAR AGAIN!

State-mandated testing (ISTEP) will begin on Monday, March 1st, and continue through Friday, March 5th. These tests are given in grades 3-5. These tests have always been important, however now with the new "No Child Left Behind" federal law, they are even more important to our children and to our school. The state and federal governments have begun an accountability system whereby schools will be judged according to the scores received on these tests. There will be serious consequences for schools that have low performance scores or do not make significant improvement from year to year. Our children and our teachers have been working very hard reviewing standards and preparing for the upcoming tests. We have planned and prepared for a very positive testing experience, however, as always, we need parent support to truly be successful. Please, unless a child is truly sick, do not allow him/her to miss a day in the testing period.

### HOW CAN YOU HELP PREPARE YOUR CHILD FOR A GOOD TESTING SITUATION?

- Please give your child positive encouragement and support. Let him/her know how important it is for them to do their Personal Best!
- Enforce appropriate bedtimes
- Send your child to school with a good breakfast
- Schedule doctor/dentist appointments around testing schedules. Arrive at school on time....this will enable the entire class to start testing on time and

# "Nurse's Comer"

The information printed in Our Nurse's Corner articles are NOT things that are going around the school, they are for informational purposes only!

RINGWORM (Tinea Capitis; Tinea Corporis)

### **SYMPTOMS:**

Ringworm of the scalp begins as a small pimple which grows and spreads, leaving scaly patches of temporary baldness.

Ringworm of the body appears as flat, spreading, ring-shaped lesions. The outside is usually reddish and filled with pus while the skin on the inside tends to return to normal.

### **INCUBATION PERIOD:**

4-14 days Tinea Capitis 10-14 days Tinea Corporis 4-10 days Tinapedis unknown.

### **CONTAGIOUS PERIOD:**

As long as any untreated lesions are present and spores persist on contaminated materials.

#### **RETURN TO SCHOOL:**

Under medical care. While under treatment, infected children should be excluded from gymnasiums, swimming pools and activities likely to lead to exposure of others.
